Scott Katz, who joined the firm in 2009, focuses his practice on both criminal defense and civil litigation. Scott has worked on a wide variety of criminal and civil matters in state and federal court, both at the trial level and on appeal.

During his tenure at the AG's Office, Scott briefed and argued appeals before the Massachusetts Supreme Judicial Court, the Massachusetts Appeals Court, and the First Circuit Court of Appeals.
